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| <ul style="list-style-type: none"> 1) Approved water efficient landscape materials must be installed within the service area of MMWD only. 2) Rebates are offered on a first-come, first-served basis and are subject to availability of funds. 3) Eligible water-efficient landscape materials include materials that improve water-use efficiency in the landscaping as determined by Marin Municipal Water District staff. 4) Applicants must have an existing irrigation system with an operable automatic controller. 5) Installation costs, sales tax, delivery charges, and new construction are not rebated. 6) Applicants must agree that all sites are subject to inspection by water agency staff prior to, or after rebate distribution. 7) Upon inspection, if eligible rebated landscape material is not installed, the rebate will be denied. 8) Rebate applications must be postmarked within 90 days of purchase date. Rebates may take up to 6 weeks to process. 9) Original itemized receipt(s) dated after March 1, 2007, must be sent in with application. Please make copies of original receipt(s) as they will not be returned. | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> 10) Incomplete applications and those without original purchase receipts will be denied. 11) A separate application must be submitted for each metered address. 12) Rebates apply to water meter(s) providing water for irrigation, i.e. meters serving indoor and outdoor and dedicated irrigation only. 13) Residential customers are eligible for rebates up to \$350.00 per meter. 14) Multi-family and commercial customers are eligible for rebates up to \$650.00 per mixed use water meter. 15) Commercial customers are eligible for rebates up to \$3,500.00 per dedicated irrigation water meter. 16) Rebates are awarded at the discretion of MMWD staff. 17) Customer accounts must be current and non-delinquent (i.e. no past due balances) at the time the rebate application is processed. No rebate will be given to customers whose accounts are delinquent. 18) The water-efficient landscape materials eligible for this rebate program are listed on reverse side of this form. 19) Applicant certifies that all necessary permissions have been obtained from the property owner, if applicant is not the owner themselves. |
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TAX INFORMATION: *(all rebates require a tax identification number or social security number)*

Incentives are taxable and if the cumulative amount of all incentives and any other payments paid in a calendar year equals or is greater than \$600.00, it will be reported to the IRS unless you are exempt. Marin Municipal Water District will report our rebate as income to you on Form 1099-Misc, unless you have checked Corporation or Tax Exempt tax status. You are urged to consult your tax advisor concerning the taxability of rebates. Marin Municipal Water District is not responsible for any taxes that may be imposed on you as a result of this rebate.
