**December 10:** Rainwater Harvesting Basics ♠ 10 am-Noon ♠ Free

An introduction to rain harvesting that includes a presentation and hands-on exploration of the "nuts and bolts" in a basic residential system.

**January 14:** Laundry to Landscape ♠ 10 am-Noon ♠ Free

In this hands-on workshop you will learn how to use water from your clothes washer for landscape irrigation. These simple graywater systems can be installed in your home without a building permit.

**February 18:** Introduction to Rainwater Harvesting ♠ 9:30 am-5 pm ♠ Free for MMWD customers, \$25 for non-customers

Taught by staff from the American Rainwater Catchment Systems Association (ARCSA), this course normally costs \$75—and lunch is included! Concepts and techniques are introduced on harvesting rain for non-potable uses such as landscape irrigation and wildlife management. Demonstrations reinforce the concepts learned through rainfall simulations and the use of a simple rainfall harvesting system.
