

Directions to Leo T. Cronin Fish Viewing Area

The Leo T. Cronin Fish Viewing Area, located along Lagunitas Creek in West Marin, is one of the San Francisco Bay Area's most popular fish-viewing areas. It is open to the public sunrise to sunset. The best time to see spawning fish is in December and January. The small parking lot fills up quickly, particularly on weekends.

From Highway 101:

1. Take the Sir Francis Drake Blvd exit and head west. Travel about 9 miles, through Greenbrae, Kentfield, Ross, San Anselmo, Fairfax, and out to the San Geronimo Valley.
2. Continue west for about another 5 miles, past the towns of Woodacre, San Geronimo, Forest Knolls, and Lagunitas.
3. Cross over Shafter Bridge, which is about ½ mile west of the Lagunitas store, and immediately turn left, into the parking lot of the Leo T. Cronin Fish Viewing Area. If you pass the sign on the right for Samuel P. Taylor State Park you have gone too far.
