# Wildfire Task Force - Objective

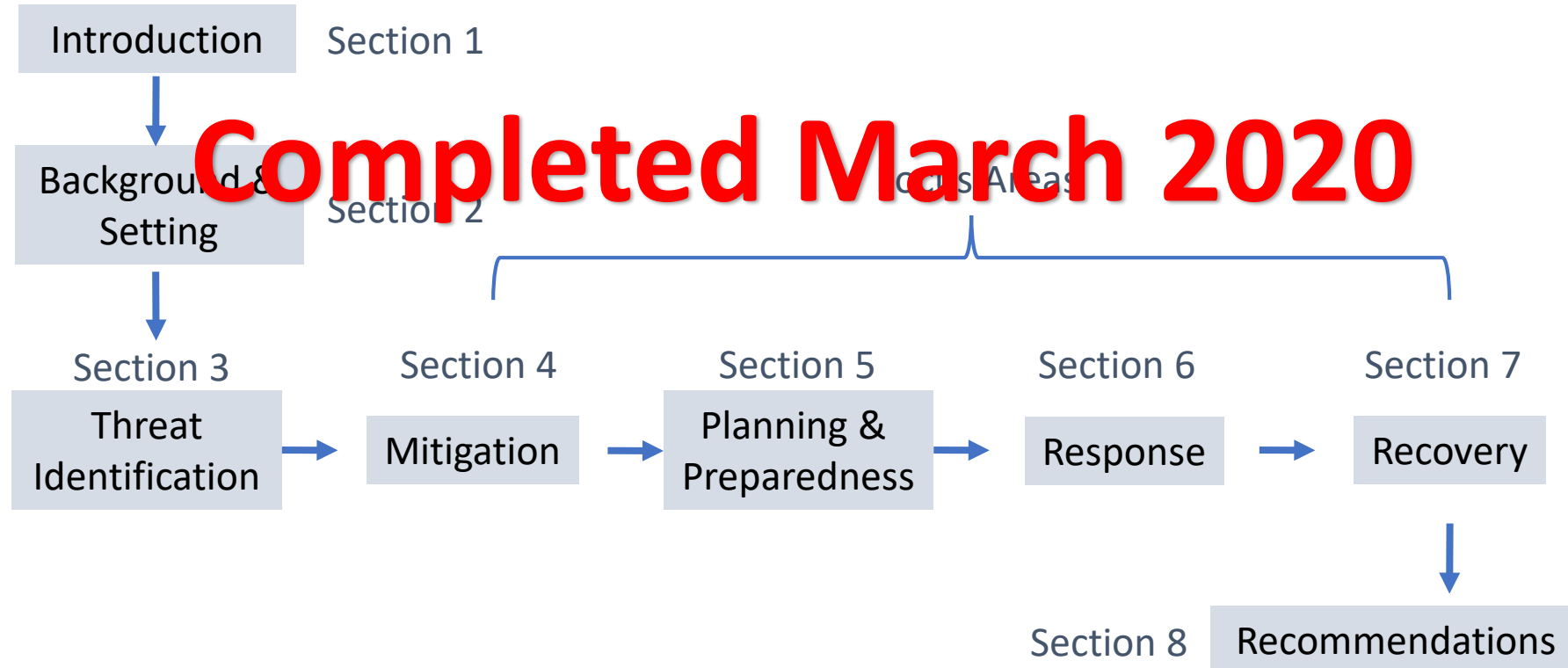

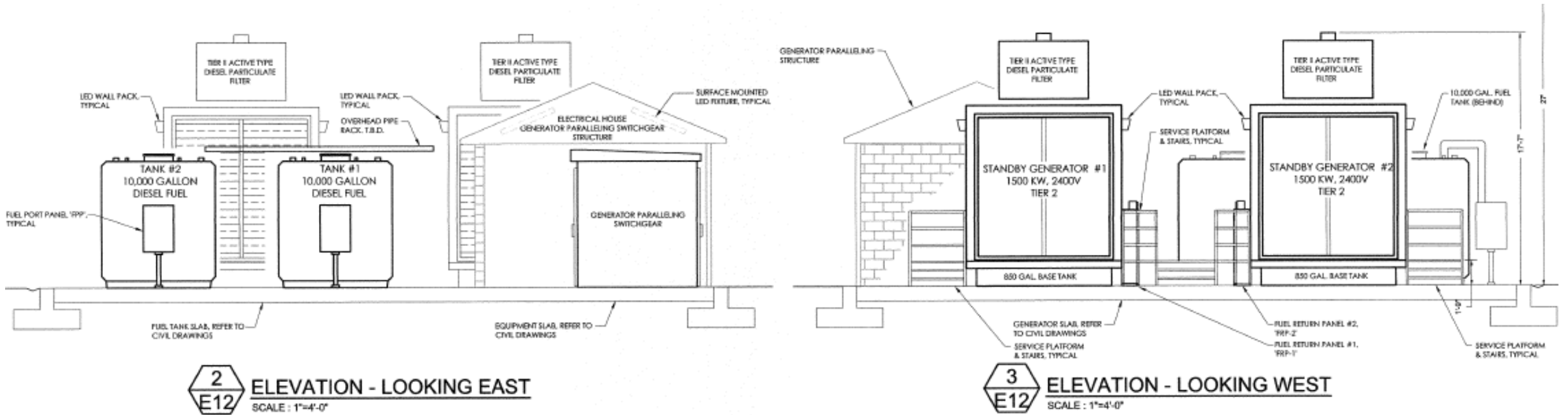

# Other Implemented Actions

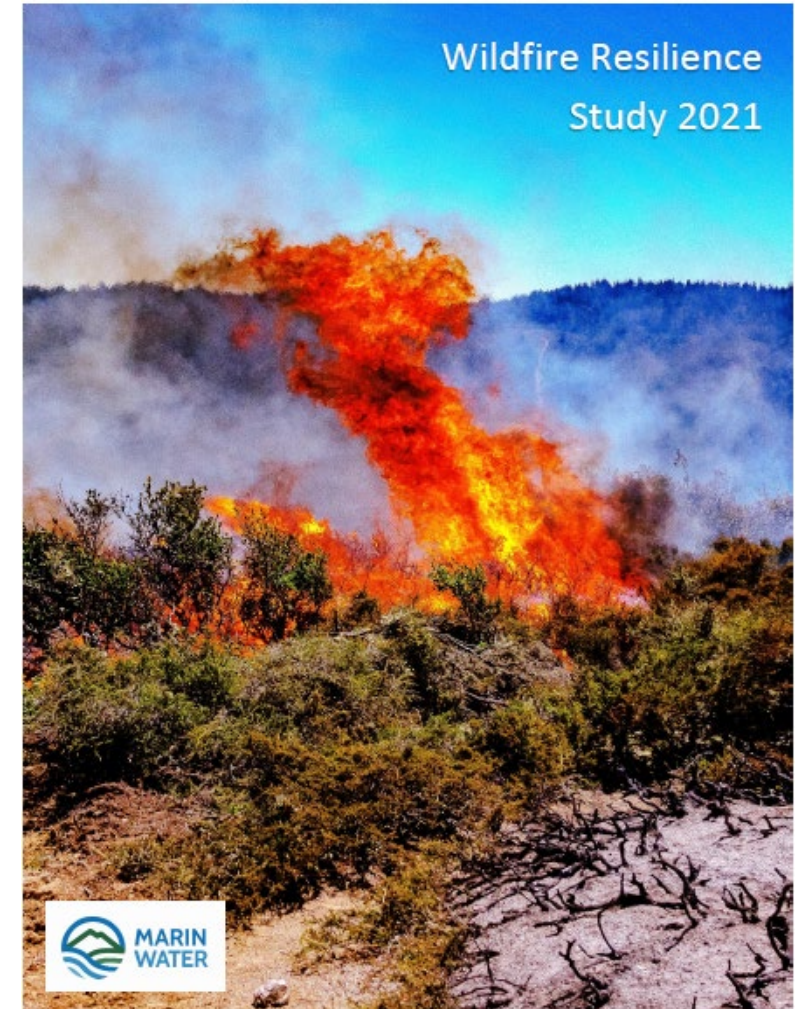
- Removed remove barbeques at Rifle Camp, Barth's Retreat, Laurel Dell, and Potrero Camp

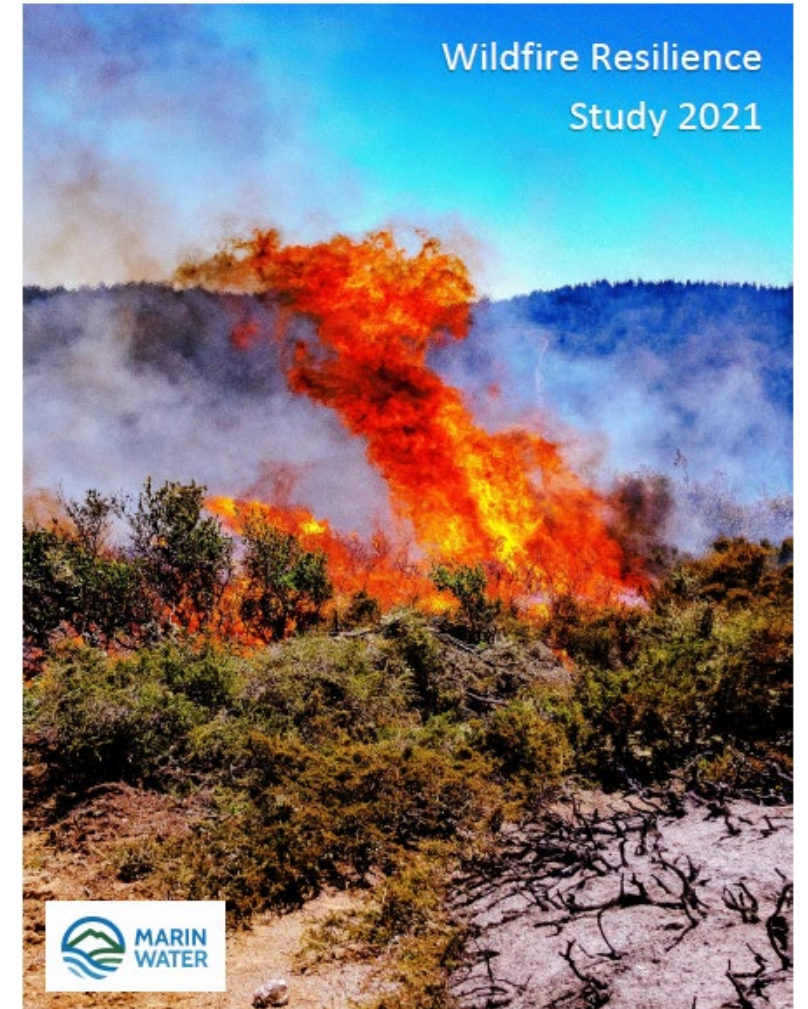
