I write to implore the MMWD to maintain its current ban on e-bikes within the district. PLEASE do not allow e-bikes. The mountain bikes are bad enough, and indeed, should be banned. The Phoenix Lake area is a like a motocross; dangerous to walk because the speed limits are not enforced and it is like a freeway. If mountain bikes were banned, there also would not be the problem associated with illegal use of single track trails.

Considering allowing some e-bikes and not others is a joke. The manufacturers are all over this one already. They are producing e-mountain bikes that are indistinguishable from regular mountain bikes – they even use the term "stealth."

When I saw my first snake run over by a mountain bike in the 1980s (at Phoenix Lake), it was obvious that increasing bike traffic was going to have an adverse effect on wildlife. Allowing ebikes will result in an explosion of users, and a corresponding increase in wildlife deaths and the illegal use of single track trails.

Phoenix Lake used to be a fantastic place to hike. Now, with mountain biking and dog walking advertised on the internet it has become a freeway and an open toilet for pet dogs. Really sad. Please don't make the situation worse by allowing e-bikes. It will be a disaster visited upon an existing disaster.
