


Review of Drought Conditions

Total Reservoir Storage




Cumulative Rainfall

Monthly Potable Water Production




Tracking Average Daily Production

Drought Response: Water Supply Initiatives


- Soulajule Reservoir
- Kastania Pump Station Rehabilitation
- Environmental Releases
- Consideration of Multi-year Drought Projects
 - Looking at feasibility of temporary desalination and water transfers

Drought Conservation Targets

Water Conservation Goals

- Overall 40% reduction from all customers
- December 1st: 30,000 acre-feet total reservoir storage
- Ongoing monitoring and reporting to the Board status as compared to established conservation goals (utilizing water production data)

Residential Targets for Indoor Use



- Indoor water targets guided by industry standards
- Outdoor water use savings guided by
 2 days per week sprinkler irrigation restrictions

^{*}gpcd = gallons per capita per day

Increased Conservation

Next Level of Increased Conservation

If additional conservation efforts are needed, staff is considering:

- Limit irrigation to one day per week
- No outdoor irrigation
- Per capita or household allocation
- Restrictions on new connections
- Eliminate summer allocation
