We are in a severe drought.

Marin is in a historic drought. Our goal is a 40% reduction in overall water use districtwide. It is essential that we all save as much water as possible. Visit MarinWater.org/Conserve to see how you can save water.

There are water use restrictions.

More ways to

save water.

- Spray irrigation is limited to one day a week. Each community has a designated watering day (see your watering day at MarinWater.org/WaterRules).
- Drip irrigation is limited to any two days per week.
 Do not water between 9 a.m. and 7 p.m.
- system and watering by hand, only when necessary. Spot watering can be done on any day of the week.
 Garden boses must have a shutoff pozzi
- Garden hoses must have a shutoff nozzle.

• We recommend turning off your irrigation

- Do not wash driveways or sidewalks.
- Do not wash vehicles at home.

Outdoors

- Replace your lawn using our Cash for Grass or Mulch Madness rebates.
- Water by hand, only if necessary.
- Install a graywater system that reuses water for irrigation.
- Install a pool or spa cover to prevent evaporation and receive a rebate.
- Drive your beautifully dirty car. A dirty car is a badge of honor during a drought.

Indoors

- Take shorter showers.
- Do laundry and dishes only when you have full loads.
- Turn the water off while brushing your teeth.
- Capture and reuse water from your shower as you wait for the water to get warm.
- Don't flush the toilet as often, each flush you skip saves water.
