## **Additional Drought Response Actions to Curb Demands**

- Planned Actions:
  - Winter irrigation prohibition (October 19)
    Prohibit pool filling (October 19)
    Net Zero Offset Program (November 2021)
    Drought rates (TBD)
- Depending on winter precipitation, runoff, and reservoir levels: OPotable water shall only be used for health and safety.
