

Marin County Positivity Rates

Marin County

17,354 total confirmed cases

20 new cases (0.1% increase) 5.6 cases per 100K (7-day average)



As of October 27, 2021

- 7 day average: 5.6 per 100k residents
- New Cases: 20 cases
- 0.1% from 7 days prior
- 93.3% over age 12 are fully vaccinated

District Vaccination and Covid 19 Case

- 75% of District staff are fully vaccinated.
- 7 Covid Positive Cases
- No Community Spread
- No Known Workplace Exposure

Options Considered for MMWD Policy

- Mandatory Vaccinations;
- Weekly Testing for unvaccinated employees; or
- No Change follow CalOSHA rule
 - Follow Agency Covid Protection Plan

District's Vaccination Policy – Key Points

 Proof of Vaccination (with recommended booster shots as advised by health authorities)

or

- Weekly Testing
 - Logistics and Testing Details to be Determined
 - Possible Options: onsite, drive-up or other testing options)
 - District Pays for Testing
 - Testing on District Time
- Confidential Files for Vaccination Records

Communication to Staff

- Policy introduced to staff during the GM's Brown Bag
- Everyone email to advise on finalized policy
- Instructions for unvaccinated staff regarding weekly testing

Next Steps

- Continue and finalize discussions with the union
- Determine policy effective date
- Continue ongoing communication to staff on workplace safety precautions and the importance of vaccinations
- Make any updates, to the policy, based on CDC or other health authority recommendations or mandates
