SUMMARY

Staff will provide an update on recent, ongoing, and planned Communications and Outreach Activities, including an update on the department's progress on the Strategic Communications Work Plan for FY 2022-23.

DISCUSSION

The Communications & Public Affairs team has continued progress on its 2022-23 Strategic Communications Work Plan, which was first presented to the board at a quarterly Committee/Special Board of Directors meeting in May 2022. The work plan consists of nine key components – Content Creation, Collateral Development, Branding, Digital Presence, Community Events & Partnerships, Earned Media, Paid Media, Internal Outreach and Emergency Preparedness – each representing an important focus area that helps to guide the team's weekly, quarterly and annual work. Along with work in those nine categories, the Communications Team regularly engages in a variety of communications support activities that are critical to ensuring the District speaks with one voice on important projects and initiatives. Staff will provide a presentation to update the Board on the progress made on the Strategic Communications Work Plan and other District outreach activities.
