On a spring day, a Water Use Efficiency Specialist with Marin Water visited a customer's home. The homeowner had just received a letter regarding a spike in water use the previous month, and he wasn't sure what to do.

In just an hour, our specialist found the customer's irrigation program was running much longer than necessary and the system had developed a large leak near the driveway. Indoors, high-flow showerheads and faucets were also identified as ways to lower water use. The result: Thousands of gallons of water saved every year, a reduced monthly bill and one happy customer.

This homeowner's story is fairly typical. As part of Marin Water's Conservation Assistance Program, our specialists regularly audit water use for a half-dozen customers each week. On average, they find

thousands of gallons per year in savings.

"There's always something," said Gregory Plumb, a Water Use Efficiency Specialist with Marin Water.




About Our Water Supply

75% of the District's water supply comes from local reservoirs located on Mt. Tamalpais and in west Marin. Here's a look at storage, usage, and rainfall data:


Reservoir Storage

% of total storage capacity as of 3/15/22




Water Usage
